The Limestone County Sheriff's Rodeo sponsors a Rodeo Queen Contest. There are seven divisions for the Queen Contest ranging from ages 3-4, 5-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-18, and 18-26. Horsemanship is optional for all divisions except "Miss Limestone Sheriff's Rodeo", the 18-26 year old division. Horsemanship for the 18-26 year old division requires horsemanship participation. Contestants in this division compete to win a "Running P" custom-made trophy saddle, a custom belt buckle, a watch, scholarship money and much more. The entry fee for this division is \$100.00.
